- Gary and Ian met with Temple Administration (Dean of Students and Greek Advisor) on 5/6/2009 and the university said they are ready to accept and support our revitalization efforts.
- Ian will begin building awareness and actively recruiting in the fall semester.
- The alumni association agreed to pay for Ian's housing expenses, estimated at \$600/month for approx. 8 months. Gary will submit a budget. The alumni association would submit a request to the House Corp to pay this expense.
